GENERATION AND CONSUMPTION OF POWER IN U.P. AND DELHI

Will the Minister of POWER be pleased to state:

- (a) the annual losses being incurred by Uttar Pradesh and Delhi State Electricity Boards at present;
- (b) the present consumption of power in the above States and the percentage of power generated by their own resources;
- (c) the names of areas from which remaining supply of power is made; and
- (d) the efforts being made by the Government of Delhi & Uttar Pradesh to attain self- sufficiency in power generation along with the contribution of the Union Government?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF POWER(SHRIMATI JAYAWANTI MEHTA)

(a) to (d): The commercial losses of the power utilities of Uttar Pradesh (Uttar Pradesh Power Corporation Ltd.) and Delhi (Delhi Vidyut Board) and present consumption of power in these States are given as under:

To meet the power requirement of Uttar Pradesh and Delhi a capacity addition of 710 MW and 225.78 MW respectively have been

programmed during Tenth Plan in the State sector. Both of the States will also have their shares in the Central Sector projects.
