ESTABLISHMENT OF MONITORING COMMITTEE

Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government propose to set up a Monitoring Committee to keep track of timely implementation of the supportive measures suggested by various bodies including Planning Commission in the context of globalization;
- (b) whether globalization has simultaneously resulted in employment generation and loss of employment;
- (c) whether a committee of implementation in the process of restructuring and development has been formed;
- (d) if so, whether any concrete efforts in this regard have been made; and
- (e) if so, the time by which the committee for implementation in the process of restructuring and development is likely to be constituted?

Answer

- (a): A three tier monitoring mechanism has been put in place to keep track of timely implementation of various measures including schemes, projects and programmes during the Tenth Plan Period.
- (i) Regular monitoring by every Ministry/Department of all schemes / projects / programmes implemented by it.
 - (ii) Quarterly Performance Review (QPR) by the Planning Commission to monitor progress of both physical and financial performance of schemes and implementation of policy initiatives of each Ministry / Department.
 - (iii) Periodic monitoring of Priority Agenda for Action by the Prime Minister's Office and Committee of Secretaries.
- (b): No direct link can be drawn between globalization and the creation or loss of employment.
- (c) (d) & (e): There is no proposal to constitute a Committee for Implementation in the process of restructuring and development.
