Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Petrol Pump at Mulund (East), Mumbai has not been started till now;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the name of PSU to which this pump has been allotted; and
- (d) the time by which the same is likely to be started?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM & NATURAL GAS (SHRIMATI SUMITRA MAHAJAN)

(a) to (d): Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited (BPCL) has a proposal to set up a retail outlet dealership (petrol pump) at Mulund (East), Mumbai, for which the Company has approached the State Government of Maharashtra for allotment of a suitable plot of land. Commissioning of the outlet will depend on allotment of land by that Government. In the normal course, BPCL is expected to commission the retail outlet in about three months after allotment of land.
