(a)to(d): Survey for a new line from Jeypore to Nawarangpur (45 Km.) has been taken up. The Survey Report is expected during this year. Further consideration of the project will be possible once the survey report becomes available. At present, there is no proposal for a new line beyond Nawarangpur upto Kesinga.
