**Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES be pleased to state:**

- (a) the estimated cost and target date fixed for completion of the ongoing irrigation projects in the country, State-wise and project-wise;
- (b) whether the Government have announced recently that all the pending projects will be completed during the next two years;
- (c) if so, the concrete steps being taken in this regard; and
- (d) the amount released by the Centre to each State particularly the Government of Gujarat for the purpose during each of the last three years?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES (SMT. BIJOYA CHAKRAVARTY)

- (a) The state-wise details of ongoing 162 major and 240 medium irrigation projects which have spilled over into IX Plan alongwith their estimated cost, total amount spent thereon, and the estimated amount required for their completion is given in the enclosed Statement-I. The completion period of any project depends on various factors such as its size, availability of land, obtaining clearance from various Central Appraising Agencies by the state governments, geological conditions etc. Equally important are funds allotted by the State Governments to individual projects.
- (b) State-wise number of projects likely to be completed by the end of IX Five Year Plan as reported by the state governments is given in the enclosed Statement-II.
- (c) & (d) Irrigation being a state subject, irrigation projects are taken up for implementation by the state governments themselves out of their own resources and as per their own priorities. The Centre has, however, launched Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme (AIBP) since 1996- 97 for providing Central Loan Assistance (CLA) to the State Governments for accelerating implementation of ongoing irrigation and multipurpose projects on which substantial progress has been made and which are beyond the resource capability of the state governments. The state-wise details of CLA released to the states during last three years is given in the enclosed Statement-III.
