(a) & (b) Yes, Sir. Commodity and monetary assistance provided to the States for strengthening their food laboratories during 2000-01 and 2001-02. The details of assistance provided to the States is given at Annex.

Under the World Bank Assisted Capacity Building Project on Food and Drugs, State Food Laboratories are being set up in the three newly created States and Sikkim, while laboratories in the other States are being strengthened.
