**Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government have received any complaints about irregularities committed ;in the recruitment to the Delhi Police;
- (b) if so, the details thereof alongwith the total number of complaints received in this regard during the last three years and as on date;
- (c) the average number of complaints looked into by the Government out of these complaints; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government for making fair recruitment ;in Delhi Police?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSIONS (SHRI HARIN PATHAK)

(a) to (c): During the last three year and upto 21st July, 2003, Delhi Police has received 534 such representations/complaints(including applications filed before the Central Administrative Tribunal ), mostly from the candidates who were declared unsuccessful. These representations/complaints mainly related to not giving adequate weightage to their performance in the text of or questioned the procedures followed. All such representations/complaints are looked into and corrective action, wherever justified, is taken.

(d): Recruitment is made strictly as per the recruitment and the instructions issued by the Government/Delhi Police from time to time.
