**Will the Minister of PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSIONS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether a large number of posts are lying vacant in various Ministries/Departments of the Union Government;
- (b) if so, the number thereof Ministry-wise, category-wise as on date and the number of posts reserved for SCs/STs and OBCs separately out of them;
- (c) whether the Government propose to fillup these vacancies during the current year; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

**Answer**

(a), (b), (c) & (d): Information relating to total number of posts lying vacant in various Ministries is not centrally maintained. Recruitment is a continuous process and it is possible that a number of posts including those reserved for SCs/STs and OBCs, remain vacant at a particular time. Action to fill up the vacant posts, including those reserved for various classes, is taken by the concerned Ministries/Departments and recruitment, wherever necessary, is organised through the recruiting agencies.
