DEVELOPMENT OF RAILWAY STATIONS

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Railway Station in Telengana Region like Karim Nagar, Mahaboobnagar, etc. are not being improved as compared to the other Railway Stations;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the action proposed to get the Railway Station in Telengana Region inspected and the action taken to make necessary improvements for passengers facilities?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI DIGVIJAY SINGH)

(a): No, Sir.

(b): Does not arise.

(c): All Railway Stations, including those in Telengana Region, are inspected by field units periodically. Existing passenger amenities are reviewed every year and deficiencies are recouped. Any additional facilities, required as a result of growth of traffic at Stations, are proposed in Annual Works Programme of Railway depending upon availability of funds and other relative priority of works.
