- (a) whether Andhra Pradesh Government have requested the Union Government for recommending to World Bank for sanction of a Structural Adjustment Loan (SAL) of Rs.1610 crores, while considering the resources estimates of the State for financing the annual plan;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the reaction of the Government thereon?

(a), (b) & (c): Yes Sir. Andhra Pradesh Government's request for Structural Adjustment Loan (SAL) from World Bank has been posed to the World Bank. The amount, tranches and reform content of the SAL will depend upon completion of programme. Inclusion of SAL resources in resource estimates of the State is conditional upon actual availability of such resources from World Bank in the relevant financial year.
