(a) to (d): The Patch doubling of Bangalore-Kengeri (12.45 km) and Kengeri- Ramanagaram (32.43 km) sections of Bangalore-Mysore line have been included in the Railway Budget. No target date has yet been fixed. The work would be progressed and completed in the coming years as per the operational priority and availability of resources.
