Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a number of items are manufactured in various manufacturing units under Railways;
- (b) if so, the names and details of the items manufactured in these units alongwith names of the units in which these items are manufactured;
- (c) whether these units are running in profit;
- (d) if so, the total investment made in each manufacturing unit till the end of October, 2002;
- (e) the annual average amount of profit earned by each unit during the previous years; and
- (f) the efforts made towards modernising these manufacturing units?

Answer

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) to (f) OF LOK SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 623 ASKE S/SHRI HARIBHAI CHAUDHARY AND MANSINH PATEL TO BE ANSWERED ON 21.11.2002 REGARDING MANUFACT UNITS

(a) Yes, Sir. Rolling Stock i.e. both Coaches and Locomotives and some of the major components and assemblies are manufactured in the Indian Railway's Productions Units.

(b) There are six production units under the Ministry of Railways. Names of the units and the principal items manufactured are as under:-

Name	Items manufactured
1. Chittaranjan Locomotive Works, Chittaranjan.	Electric Locomotives
2. Diesel Locomotive Worls, Varanasi.	Diesel Locomotives
3. Integral Coach Factory, Chennai.	Coaches
4. Rail Coach Factory, Kapurthala.	Coaches
5. Wheel & Axle Plant, Bangalore.	Wheels Axles
6. Diesel Component Works, Patiala.	Diesel-Electric Loco-rebuilding

(c), (d) & (e) Does not arise. The six production units under the Ministry of Railways are in-house production organizations, operating on a 'no-profit no-loss' basis. The full cost of production is transferred to the consuming units by way of appropriately fixed transfer prices for the various items that are manufactured.

(f) Modernisation is ongoing process. It is carried out as and when requirement arises.
