GAUGE CONVERSION OF YELAHANKA-BANGARPET RAIL LINE

- (b) the estimated cost of the project;
- (c) the progress made and the amount spent thereon so far; and

(a) to (d) : No, Sir. The work has been completed and commissioned from Yelahanka to Chickbalapur and Kolar to Bangarpet. Estimated cost of the work is for Rs. 57.54 cr. The expenditure upto March 2001 is Rs. 57.4 cr. There is no proposal to take up gauge conversion between Chickballapur and Kolar.
