**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government have conducted intensive surprise checks during the last three years to ensure that unreserved passengers are not allowed entry into the reserved coaches in the mail and express trains in all the railway zones in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of passengers travelling without reservations who were apprehended on each occasion and the amount of money realised from them as fine, zone-wise; and
- (d) the action taken against the conductors/TTEs of these coaches for allowing the unreserved passengers in reserved coaches?
