**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government are aware that 12 voluntary train ticket examiners have been examining the tickets of the passengers without bearing any identity card in the Bharatpur district of Rajasthan;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government propose to issue any identity card to these train ticket examiners; and
- (d) if so, by when and if not, the reasons therefor?

**Answer**

(a) to (d): As per Court's orders, twelve volunteer ticket checkers are working at Bharatpur. At present, they are assisting the regular ticket checking staff. They shall be issued regular Identity Cards as and when they are absorbed on the Railways.
