TRAIN FROM DELHI TO JAIPUR VIA ALWAR DURING DAY TIME

**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government are aware that there is no train from Delhi to Jaipur via Alwar during day time for the people of Alwar district of Rajasthan;
- (b) whether the Government propose to run a new train on this route;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI BANDARU DATTATRAYA)

(a) to (d): No, Sir. Presently, 2413 Delhi-Jaipur Express, 2015 New Delhi-Ajmer Shatabdi Express, 4311 Bareilly-New Bhuj Ala Hazrat Express, 9264 Delhi Sarai Rohilla-Probandar Express and 9266 Dehradun- Okha Uttaranchal Express are available between 05.10 hours and 13.40 hours ex-Delhi area, reaching Jaipur via Alwar between 10.30 hours and 19.25 hours. Introduction of additional trains in this sector is not feasible, at present, due to operational and resource constraints.
