- (c) the funds proposed to be spent by the Government thereon; and

(a) to (d) No, Sir. However, there is one sanctioned work for replacement of existing Railway Bridge No.249 over Yamuna between Shahdara and Delhi Main Railway Station at estimated cost of Rs.67.11 crore which is likely to be completed in next three years.
