- (d) if so, the latest steps the Government propose to take to check activities of ISI in the country?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 8 FOR 2.12.2003 REGARDING ACTIVITIES:

(a) & (b): The Pak ISI has been aiding, abetting and supporting terrorism and anti-national activities in various parts of the country.

(c) & (d): In order to deal with the situation, the Government has pursued a well coordinated and multi-pronged approach which includes strengthening the border management to check infiltration, galvanizing the intelligence machinery, improved technology, weaponry and equipments for security forces both at the Centre and in the States, neutralizing plans of terrorist groups/anti-national elements/ISI agents by well coordinated intelligence based operations. As a result of the coordinated action by the Central and State intelligence and security agencies, a number of Pak backed terrorist/espionage modules have been detected/neutralized in various parts of the country.
