**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS (SHRI VIJAY GOEL)

(a) & (b) The Government does not hold cricket matches/series and it is for the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) to hold and organize such cricket events. However, this Ministry considers the proposal of BCCI for cricket series with any country in consultation with the Ministries of External Affairs and Home Affairs seeking their comments from political and security angles, respectively. This Ministry has not received any proposal concerning Indo-Pak Cricket series matches during 2004 from BCCI, so far.
