(a) & (b): A large number of IT Graduates pass out every year from Institutes / Universities administered / maintained by the Central Government, State Governments and Private bodies. Details in this regard are not maintained centrally. However, as per Interim Report of the Task Force on HRD in IT, there are 1032 colleges offering IT courses with an intake capacity of 66214 students. In addition IITs, IIITs, IISc Bangalore have an intake capacity of around 1200 students in IT courses.
