Will the Minister of SURFACE TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the World Bank/Asian Bank or other financial institutions has given \$ 51 crore for the National Highways of Uttar Pradesh and Bihar;
- (b) if so, whether the National Highways of Uttar Pradesh and Bihar have been identified;
- (c) if so, the details of the National Highways identified in both States; and
- (d) the time by which the Government propose to spend the total amount on all these projects?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI HUKUMDEO NARAYAN YADAV)

(a) to (d): The World Bank has approved a loan amounting to \$ 51.6 crores for upgradation of National Highway No.2 in stretches aggregating to a length of 477 Kms. of NH 2 in the States of U.P. and Bihar between Agra and Barwa Adda. The loan amount is to be utilized before the closing date of 30th June, 2006. However, the work is targeted for completion by December 2003.
