(a) to (c): Ministry of Food Processing Industries is operating six Plan Schemes during the Tenth Plan under which financial assistance in the form of grant-in-aid is extended to Non-Government Organizations/Cooperatives/Private Industries/Public Sector Undertakings/Human Resource Development Organizations/Research & Development Institutions for the development of processed food sector. The percentage and quantum of assistance vary from scheme to scheme.
