- (a) whether the Government are contemplating to set up State level Directorates and permit them to frame safety rules against radiation;
- (b) if so, the time frame worked out therefor; and
- (c) if not, other preventive measures being taken in this regard?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF ATOMIC ENERGY (SMT. VASUNDHARA RAJE)

- (a) There is no proposal to constitute State level Directorates to monitor radiation safety.
- (b) Does not arise.
- (c) The existing system of safety review in the cases of projects and operating plants will continue. In view of this, no further preventive measures are necessary.
