INLAND CONTAINER DEPOT AT BHIWADI

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government propose to set up an Inland Container Depot at Bhiwadi;
- (b) if so, the expenditure likely to be incurred thereon;
- (c) the time by which it is likely to be set up;
- (d) whether the Government of Rajasthan has also requested the Railways to connect Bhiwadi with Dharuheda-Rewari and Sirsa by the broad gauge rail line; and
- (e) if so, the action taken by the Government thereon?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI BANDARU DATTATRAYA)

(a) to (c): Rajasthan Small Industries Corporation Limited (RAJSICO) a Government of Rajasthan undertaking is already operating a road-linked Inland Container Depot (ICD) from Bhiwadi. There is no proposal to set up an ICD at Bhiwadi by Container Corporation of India (CONCOR) as it is already operating a rail-linked ICD from Rewari which is approximately 25 Kms from Bhiwadi.

(d) and (e): A request has been received from Government of Rajasthan for construction of rail line between Rewari-Bhiwadi. A survey for construction of rail-link between Rewari-Bhiwadi is in progress.
