ROAD OVER BRIDGES

**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether there is an immediate requirement of over bridges near Goomti No.1 and Manpur in Gaya district to connect Nalanda, Barh, Rajgiri Blocks headquarters where there is huge traffic running up and down;
- (b) if so, the steps taken to provide road over-bridges at the said locations; and
- (c) the time by which these bridges are likely to be constructed ?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS ( SHRI BANDARU DATTATRAYA )

- (a) & (b) : The work of Road Over Bridge in lieu of level crossing No. 67/A between Manpur- Bandhua has already been sanctioned on cost sharing basis. State Government has not yet furnished estimate for approaches (their portion of work). However, site plans and general arrangement drawing have already been approved. Rs. 20 lakhs have been provided during the current year for this work.
- (c): Depends upon construction of approaches by State Government. Railway will complete their portion of work (Bridge over tracks) before or simultaneously with the work of approaches.
