- (a) the system adopted by the Government to allot new bogies to various Zones;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, the steps taken to adopt same system for allotting the bogies;
- (d) the number of new bogies given to South Central Railways in 2002-2003; and
- (e) whether there is any proposal to provide more new bogies to South Central Railways; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI BANDARU DATTATRAYA)

- (a) to (c) : New Coaches allotted to Zonal Railways for introduction of new services/augmentation as planned and also for replacement of overaged stock to the extent possible within the allocated resources.
- (d) to (f) : South Central Railway have been allotted 26 new passenger carrying coaches during year 2002-03. Presently, there are no further plans to allot more coaches to South Central Railway.
