- (b): Software Exports by Software Technology Parks of India (STPI)registered units centre wise (including sub Centres), during the years 2000-01, 2001-02 and 2002-03 are given in Annexure-II.

- (d): With a projected growth of about 26% an software export of Rs.17,000 crores is estimated during the year 2003-04 from Software Technology Parks of India (STPI) Bangalore.
