STOPPAGE OF TRAIN AT KALINAGAR RAILWAY STATION

**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

(a) whether the Government had decided to introduce Kalinagar Railway Station for operation of train services between Samudragarh and Katwa Railway Stations in the Eastern Railway and accordingly built up the infrastructure for stoppage of trains at Kalinagar Railway Station;

(b) whether in spite of above, the Railways have not provided stoppage of trains at Kalinagar station so far;

(c) if so, the reasons therefor; and

(d) the remedial measure taken by the Railways to provide stoppage and repair of shabby infrastructure of Kalinagar station?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS ( SHRI BASANAGOUDA R. PATIL )

(a) : Yes, Sir.

(b) to (d) : Provision of a crossing station at Kalinagar is a sanctioned work. The work is in progress. The stoppage of passenger trains at Kalinagar will be decided on the basis of passenger traffic offering and its financial viability.
