**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the railway level crossing in Rayagada town has been replaced by railway over- bridge by South Eastern Railways;
- (b) if so, whether the railway has not constructed sub-way for movement of light vehicles at the time of construction of the said bridge;
- (c) if so, the reasons therefore;
- (d) the extra expenditure to be borne by the railways as a result thereof; and
- (e) the action taken against the official responsible for it ?

(b) to (d) No subway was proposed initially when the Road Over Bridge was sanctioned in 1987- 88. Subsequently, on the request of Municipal Authorities through District, Collector Rayagada, a subway was planned on deposit terms and accordingly Railway's portion of subway was constructed. Work on approaches is held up as Rayagada Municipality has to deposit Rs. 9.93lakhs, the balance cost of approaches.
