(a) & (b): The Ministry of Rural Development had received a specialProject under `Swarnjayanti Gram SwarojgarYojana (SGSY)` for establishing 10 Metric Tonnes per day capacity Milk Powder Plant in Mujaffarpur district of Biharwith a total cost of Rs.460.00 lakh. The project was not found to be as per guidelines of the SGSY as no directbenefit was flowing to the beneficiaries. Accordingly, the State Government has been requested by them to revise the proposal.
