Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

(a) the details of schemes for the development of civil aviation works at airports in Manipur State to be implemented during Ninth Plan; and

(b) the amount granted by the Government for the same Scheme-wise alongwith the time schedule fixed for completion of the same?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI SHARAD YADAV)

(a) and (b):- Imphal Airport in Manipur belongs to the Airports Authority of India (AAI). The details of works to be implemented during 9th Five Year Plan are -

(i) Work relating to construction of Technical Block cum control Tower at a cost of Rs. 2.53 crores is in progress and is likely to be completed in October, 2000.

(ii) Construction of Peripheral Road at a cost of Rs. 1.76 crores is nearing completion.

(iii) There are plans to take up works relating to Apron, provision of shoulders, construction of link taxiway and isolation bay and resurfacing and strengthening of runway at a cost of Rs. 12.40 crores. Completion time is 24 months from the date of commencement of work.

Government is providing 40% of budgetary support to AAI.
