## Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI VINOD KHANNA)

(a) The Trade Agreement between India and Bangladesh provides for grant of transit by waterways, roadways and railways. However, at present only transit through inland waterways is being provided by Bangladesh.
