(a) whether there is any proposal to send Indo-Tibetan Border Police to Afghanistan to police the work being done by the NHAI and other agencies of the Government;

(b) if so, the details of the said proposal;

(c) whether any assessment has been made of the relevance of ITBP to undertake such works in hostile countries;

(d) if so, the details thereof; and

(e) the decision taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) - (e) Government of India would be undertaking construction of a road from Zaranj to Delaram in Afghanistan. For providing security to the members of the Indian organization and workers on the project, there is a provision for a core team of security personnel from ITBP to be present on the ground.

This has been done keeping in view security situation and similar experience in other parts of Afghanistan and support provided by local organization and authorities for security.
