(b) if so, the time by which it is likely to be completed; and

(c) the amount spent thereon so far and the amount estimated to be spent in future ?

(a) Lucknow to Barabanki is already double line. Doubling has been taken up in patches from Burhwal to Jarwal road and Jarwal Road to Gonda.

(b) within the 10th Plan subject to availability of resources.

(c) Rs.26.08 cr and Rs.119.91 cr. respectively.

A survey for construction of anew line from Shirpur to Mhow is in progress. Further consideration of the project would be possible, once the survey report becomes available. A metre gauge line already exists between Mhow and Indore.
