(a) whether India and Bahrain have signed an air service agreement; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI SHARAD YADAV)

(a): India and Bahrain have signed an Air Services Agreement on 5th April, 2000.

(b): The major features of the Agreement are as follows:-

(i) Both countries shall have the right to designate upto two airlines for operating the agreed services.

(ii) The frequency of services and capacity will be determined by the two aeronautical authorities from time to time.

(iii) The designated airlines of India can operate services to Bahrain and that of Bahrain to Delhi, Calcutta, Chennai and Thiruvananthapuram.
