(c) whether some private airlines are still offering concessional fare on this sector;

(d) if so, whether Indian Airlines/Alliance Air are proposing to offer concessions this year also; and

(e) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a): Yes, Sir.

(b): Indian Airlines had introduced the special fare on Delhi-Mumbai sector to counter the fare war initiated by the competitors on this sector.

(c): Fares (in Rupees) being levied by the airlines on Delhi-Mumbai sector are as follows:-
