(a): Department of Tourism, Government of India has not set up a Tourism Committee for North East.

(b): Does not arise.

(c) & (d): Funds are sanctioned to NE States under scheme for Integrated Development of Circuitsand Product Infrastructure and Destination Development. Besides, the Department of Tourism also provides assistance for tourism promotional activities of the North-East Region in consultation with the State Governments. Out of the total Plan allocation of the Department of Tourism 10 per cent is earmarked for development of tourism in the North-East Region. The projects sanctioned are constantly reviewed and monitored.
