- (a): Lalitpur-Satna, Rewa-Singrauli and Mahoba-Khajuraho is one project under plan head New Line. Total length is 541 km.
- (b): Rs.925 crores.
- (c): An amount of Rs. 0.51 cr. has been spent during 1999-2000 and an amount of Rs.5 cr. has been provided during current year.
- (d): No target date has yet been fixed.
