INTRODUCTION OF LOCAL TRAINS

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government propose to introduce local trains for neighbouring cities like Ambala, Agra, Alwar, Bhiwani and Hissar so as to connect these with Delhi;
- (b) if so, whether any scheme has been formulated in this regard;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the time by which the said scheme is likely to be implemented?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI DIGVIJAY SINGH)

(a) to (d) Ambala, Agra, Alwar, Bhiwani and Hissar are already connected with Delhi by direct train services. However, introduction of trains is an ongoing process subject to availability of resources, operational feasibility and traffic justification.
