RAILWAY OVER-BRIDGE AT KADIPIKONDA

- (a) whether the Railways have received request from the Government of Andhra Pradesh for construction of a Railway over-bridge at Kadipikonda in Warangal;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the action taken by the Government in this regard ?

(a) & (b) Yes, Sir. There has been correspondence with State Govt. since 1985 in this regard.

(c) The work for construction of Road Over Bridge was sanctioned in 1992-93 on cost sharing basis. Even Estimate amounting to Rs. 13.73 crore was also sanctioned in March'1993. Work could not be taken up because of change of Road Over Bridge location by State Govt. Now, joint survey has been conducted and General Arrangement Drawing prepared as per latest site details which is under finalization. An amount of Rs.1 crore has been provided during 2002-03 for this work.
