CONSTRUCTION OF ROAD OVER BRIDGE NEAR MEGHNAGAR RAILWAY STATION

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government are contemplating to construct an overbridge across the Ahmedabad Highway near Meghanagar railway station in Jhabua district of Madhya Pradesh;

(b) if so, the details thereof;and

(c) the time by which the said projects is likely to be started?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI BANDARU DATTATRAYA)

(a): No Sir. However there is a level crossing 60B in Meghnagar yard which has traffic density of less than one lakh TVUs (TVU- a unit obtained by multiplying the number of road vehicles with the number of Tains passing over the level crossing in 24 hours) hence does not qualify for replacement by Road Over Bridge on cost sharing basis.
