TIMELY SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS UNDER CENTRALLY SPONSORED SCHEMES

Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government had asked the State Governments for timely submission of proposals for release of funds under various Centrally Sponsored Tribal Development Schemes;
- (b) if so, the details of States which have submitted proposals in time in 2001-2002 financial year;
- (c) the dates on which the States submitted the proposals, State-wise; and
- (d) the dates on which Central allocation has been released to those States?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF TRIBAL AFFIARS (SHRI JUAL ORAM)

(a) Yes, Sir. The Ministry of Tribal Affairs requested all the States at different fora to submit their proposals for release of grant-in-aid under the following Centrally Sponsored Schemes:-

- (i) Boys Hostles for STs.
- (ii) Girls Hostles for STs.
- (iii) Establishment of Ashram Schools in Tribal Sub Plan Areas.
- (iv) Post Martic Scholarship.
- (v) Coaching & Allied Scheme.
- (vi) Book Bank Scheme.
- (vii) Research & Training.

They were requested that while sending their proposals, they should submit utilization certificates in respect of grants-in-aid released during previous years and a clear confirmation to the effect that matching provision exists in the State budget to enable quick processing in the Ministry of Tribal Affairs for release of grants.

(b) to (d) The date-wise record of the proposals is not maintained. However, wherever the proposals were complete in all respects, the grants-in-aid were released in time as per the State-wise details enclosed in the Statement.
