Will the Minister of STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the MPs from Delhi have not yet spent the money under the Member of Parliament Local Area Development Scheme during the last three years'
- (b) if so, the details thereof and reasons therefore;
- (c) the amount that remains yet to be spent, Member of Parliament-wise for the year 2002 and how does that compare with each of the last three years;
- (d) whether any schemes to improve the appalling conditions particularly of roads and Yamuna Ghats and clearing of Yamuna River have been proposed by the local MPs, if so, details thereof; and
- (e) the steps taken by the Government to spent the entire amount?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF STATISTICS & PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION (SHRI VIJAY GOEL)

(a) to (c) Under the Member of Parliament Local Area Development Scheme (MPLADS), MPs are entitled to make their recommendations in respect of works in accordance with the Scheme Guidelines to the District Heads concerned. After technical and administrative approval, the District Heads assign the works to implementing agencies by execution as per the established work procedures of the Government concerned. In Delhi, the MPLADS works are administered by the Municipal Corporation of Delhi. The factors hampering the utilization of the Scheme funds include shortfall in recommendations with reference to the entitlement and delays in preparation of estimates, according approvals and implementation of works. Details of funds released and unspent amounts available in respect of the Lok Sabha constituencies and Rajya Sabha MPs of Delhi are given in the enclosed statement.

(d) Details of the works of improvement of roads in Delhi under MPLADS are given in the enclosed statement. In respect of the development of Yamuna Ghats, a recommendation has been made to the Municipal Corporation of Delhi by the local MPs.

(e) All the State / UT Governments have been requested from time to time to ensure that sanctions for the works under the schemes are issued expeditiously and the funds released are utilized effectively.
