Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the amounts provided to the States by the Union Government through multinational institutions during the last three years, State-wise;
- (b) the amount spent by each of the States on administrative works during the said period;
- (c) whether the Government have requested the State Governments to curtail their administrative expenses; and
- (d) if so, the outcome thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE & COMPANY AFFAIRS SHRI ANANT G. GEETE:

- (a): A statement showing State-wise disbursement of Multilateral Aid during last three years is enclosed.
- (b): Amount spent by each of the States on administrative works is guided by the provisions made in the Budget of the States for the respective year.
- (c)& (d): In view of the requests received from State Governments for assistance to overcome their cash imbalance problems, the Government of India have requested to the State Governments to initiate appropriate steps towards prudent fiscal management and address the issue of expenditure compression within the available resources. The Government of India have also constituted a High Powered Committee under the Chairmanship of Union Finance Minister to assess the fiscal situation of the States. The Committee is to submit its report by the 30th September 2002.
