Andhyarujina, former Solicitor General of India to look into the powers for taking possession of sale and securities to banks and financial institutions has submitted its report in March, 2000 to the Government. The detailed report is under examination in consultation with Reserve Bank of India, Ministry of law and Justice and other concerned agencies for finalising a draft bill in this regard.
