(a), (b) & (c): National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) has reported that it has sanctioned an amount of Rs.31,153.94 lakhs as loan to nine States on 13 July, 2002 under Rural Infrastructure Development Fund (RIDF) - VIII.
