COMPUTERISATION OF BANK BRANCHES

Will the Minister of FINANCE AND COMPANY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the names of the banks which have computerised their branches alongwith the number of branches computerised;
- (b) whether most of the banks have not computerised their rural branches;
- (c) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (d) the State-wise number of branches of Public Sector Banks yet to be computerised; and
- (e) the time by which the branches of banks in Uttar Pradesh particularly rural branches are likely to be computerised?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE AND COMPANY AFFAIRS (SHRI ANANDRAO VITHOBA ADSUL):

- (a) The names of public sector banks which have computerised their branches as on 31.12.2002 alongwith the number of branches yet to be computerised are given in the enclosed statement.
- (b) to (e) RBI has reported that the computerisation of branches, whether urban, semi-urban and rural is a subject matter of individual bank and it is for the bank to decide about computerisation of their branches depending on, cost, benefit, available capital, economic feasibility and business viability.
