NABARD FUNDING FOR CONSTRUCTION OF GODOWNS

**Will the Minister of FINANCE AND COMPANY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government of Maharashtra has submitted any proposal to NABARD seeking funds for construction of godowns in the State under the RIDF Scheme;
- (b) if so, the locations of godowns in respect of which NABARD has accorded its approval; and
- (c) the time by which funds are likely to be sanctioned for other godowns?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE AND COMPANY AFFAIRS (SHR1 ANANDRAO VITHOBA ADSUL):

- (a) National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) has reported that Government of Maharashtra has not submitted any proposal to NABARD seeking funds out of Rural Infrastructure Development Fund (RIDF) for construction of godowns in the State.
