Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

- (a) the places in Uttar Pradesh where Inland Container Depots (ICDs) have been set up for industries and the places where DEPB facility is available;
- (b) whether industries have not availed these facilities on these places and they are facing closure;
- (c) if so, whether the Government are contemplating to withdraw such uneconomical facilities; and
- (d) is so, the details thereof?

Answer

(a) The places, where Inland Container Depots/Container Freight Stations ICDs/CFSSs are located in Uttar Pradesh, including where DEPB facility is available, are as under:-

(b) It is the endeavour of the Govt. to provide door-step facility to the traders/ industry. However, these facilities take time before they are fully patronised. The traders are free to utilise the benefits of ICDs/CFSSs.

(c) & (d) Since no financial support is given by the Govt. for establishment of such facilities, the economics of running the facility is totally determinant on the custodian of the facility. No requests for closure of any of the facilities has been received by the Govt.
