(b) the details of amount spent thereon during each of the last two years?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (PROF. RITA VERMA)

(a) The following Health and Family Welfare Schemes are being implemented in the rural and tribal areas of Kerala:

- 1) Sub-centre Scheme
- 2) Rural Family Welfare Centre
- 3) Health and Family Welfare Training Centre
- 4) Auxiliary Nursing Mid-wives Training Scheme
- 5) Multi-purpose Worker (Male) Training

Besides, World Bank funded Reproductive and Child Health (RCH) Project is also operational in Kerala. A European Commission assisted Sector Investment Programme, aiming at improvement of efficiency, cost effectiveness and sustainability of Primary and referral care concerning women, children and tribals is also under implementation in Kerala.
